STEPS TO ENROLLMENT

- Set up [myHancock portal](#) and email
- **Download** forms from AHC website
- Obtain **signatures**:
 - a. parent
 - b. high school principal/designee
- Request **unofficial transcript** from your high school
- Submit **completed and signed** forms AND **unofficial transcripts** to admissions
- Once cleared, **enroll** in classes through myHancock portal
- **Pay fees** (if applicable)
